



Q How do I remove limescale from my kettle?

A "Use descalers like the Oust All Purpose Descaler from DIY stores, or soak the kettle in a white vinegar/water solution in a 1:1 ratio overnight. The limescale will then come off easily with

light scrubbing." - Angie Koh, 41, director of Amahs On Wheels

Q After a deep-frying session, how do I remove grease around the hob?

A "Wipe the hob right after cooking. This saves time in the long run. Use a moist sponge or cloth to remove the grease - it's easier to do this while the stove is still warm. For more stubborn spills, use a solution of dishwashing liquid/warm water, or vinegar/warm water, both in a 1:1 ratio. Never use abrasive scrubbers such as steel wool on your stove." - Phoebe Leo, 42, manager at Just Relax Home Services
